St. John of God (March 8, 1495 – March 8, 1550)

"Lord be blessed for in your great kindness to me who am such a great sinner having done so many wicked things, yet you see fit to set me free from such a tremendous temptation and deception which I fell into through my own sinfulness. You have brought me into a safe harbor where I shall endeavor to serve you with all my strength. My Lord, I beg you with all my might, give me the strength of your grace and always let me see your clemency. I want to be your slave, so kindly show me what I should do. Give peace and quiet to my soul which greatly desires this. O most worthy Lord, may this creature of yours serve and praise you. May I give my whole heart and mind to

Dear Brothers and Sisters, at present, we are all in the season of Lent, preparing to participate in the Passover event of Resurrection of our Lord. At this time the passion of our Lord is a source of great strength to lead us in the spiritual journey of repentance, conversion, reconciliation and a life of joyful union with the resurrected Lord. The life of the saint of this month, St. John of God, whose feast we celebrate on the 8th of March each year, may be a spring of edification in our Lenten journey.

Born in the village of Montemor-o-Novo, Portugal to a middle-class, faith-filled parents, John was said to be abducted from his home when he was only eight years old and taken to the town of Oropesa, Spain, more than 200 miles away. Eventually, he joined the army of the Holy Roman Emperor and battled the French. John was falsely accused of theft and condemned to death. However, through the effective intervention of some influential people, he was released.

Upon the completion of his military service, he finds out that his mother had passed away after his abduction and his father had joined the Franciscans to advance in holiness. Inspired by his father, he decided to offer his life in the service of God and His people. He threw himself into a life of prayer, made a general confession, and tearfully went from church-to-church begging God for the forgiveness of his sins. Touched by the preaching of St. John of Avila, he became so aware of his own sins, that he started running through the streets like a madman, shouting for mercy. He was admitted to a mental hospital for these actions. Saint John of Avila advised him to be more actively involved in tending to the needs of others rather than in enduring personal hardships. John gained peace of heart, and shortly after left the hospital to begin work among the poor.

After receiving permission to leave the asylum, John made a pilgrimage and had a vision of the Blessed Mother who encouraged him to work for the poor and infirm. He moved forward with his desire to open a hospital. He worked tirelessly to care for them, begged for food, brought

priests to hear their confessions, and nursed them back to health. In the years following, John extended his mission of mercy to the poor, the abandoned, widows, orphans, the unemployed, prostitutes, and all who suffered. His companions in the work made up what would eventually become the Order of Hospitallers.

We can gain some valuable lessons from the life of this humble saint as follows.

- Lost Childhood of St. John: No matter what the past or childhood of a person is, God is able to create us anew and use us for his glory.
- 2. The beauty of repentance: The deep awareness of sin and conversion; being conscious of the mercy of God, leads us to a selfless life of service. Guilt can no more hinder us but faith, hope and love take us to a new height of holiness and service.
- 3. Role of Divine Mother: Our Divine Mother plays a vital role in our Passover journey, as she did in the life of St. John of God.
- 4. God's work continues till eternity: When we cooperate with God and begin to work selflessly, the work continues even after the death of the pioneer. What is needed is trust in divine plan and providence. Lent is a time to be aware of our sinfulness and repent to respond to the marvelous love of God who has plan for each one of us. In every sinner there lies a saint.

STRATEGIC PLANNING WORKSHOP

In compliance with the mandate of the Conference of Catholic Bishops of India, the Catholic Diocese of Baruipur organized a strategic planning workshop in Dishari, Diocesan Pastoral Centre, Baruipur on February 22, 2024. Its purpose was to elicit the expectations and dreams of the participants as stakeholders about how the Latin Church in India has to be significantly different by 2033 through its commissions. Thus, besides the Bishop and the V.G. there were 30 delegates comprising of all the eight diocesan commissions Secretaries, coordinator of commissions, six parish priests and assistant priests, six religious priests and sisters, six lay men and women and four youth. After the opening prayer and lighting of the lamp Most Rev. Shyamal Bose, the Bishop of the diocese, briefed about the purpose of the strategic planning workshop. Thereafter, Mr. Joachim Ashim Campoo, Fr. Kanauj Roy and Fr. Nilu Murmu who have been



specially trained to facilitate such programs led the workshop with practical demonstrations. It was followed with the division of participants into four groups for the spiritual inputs. Each group was assigned to discuss the future of two commissions and submit the bullet points to be sent to the national commission of CCBI. The following eight commissions were discussed: Liturgy, Bible, Basic Ecclesial Community, Ecumenism, Women, Family, Youth and Laity.

There was a special felicitation program on February 26, 2024 in Dishari Pastoral Centre in honour of Mr. Raj Bagh who has been newly elected as National Youth President of ICYM. The event was attended by 65 youth leaders from across the diocese. Most Rev. Shyamal Bose honoured Mr. Raj Bagh, applauded and appreciated him for his contributions as youth of the diocese. It was also a moment of inspiration for the youth present there.

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PALLI UNNAYAN SAMITI BARUIPUR

The Social service society of the diocese has become important agent in the development process of the society with its involvement in the wide range of activities comprising environmental awareness programme, disaster management and combating social evil. With the support of CEI Agro based livelihood project 31000 Kgs. of Lime powder was distributed among 700 marginalized farmers as Gypsum for recovery soil fertility from its salinity in Namkhana and Patharpratima Block on February 12 &13, 2024. Green Nets also have been provided to 80 poor farmers for enclosing their betel vine. Following this on February 26 & 27, 2024 under the leadership of Dr. Manashi and Dr. Tapas Sahana an exposure visit was conducted for 52 selected farmers at Ramkrishna Ashram KrishiVigyan Kendra, Nimpeeth under Uttoran III to provide better understanding and knowledge of climate change adoptive sustainable agriculture and organic farming.



With a view to free the society from the clutches of social evils on February 18, 2023, a rally and street play

was showcased on social violence against women and children at No.2 Charavidya village. Altogether 105 people participated in the rally and street play to raise their voice on the woeful effect of underage marriage, human trafficking, domestic violence and abuse. Mrs. Pinky Mahato, the local PRI member; Mrs. Tandra Sardar, ASHA workers; Mrs. Saroma Sardar, the ICDS workers were invited as resource persons.

They also focued on the vocational training of electrical wiring course for the youth. Those who successfully completed the course were awarded with certificate on February 28, 2024. On the same day they inaugurated the beautician course for girls. A total of 154 young men and women participated in the above-mentioned trainings and received certificates. All the participants of beautician course were awarded certificates and beautician toolkits.
