Mother of God: A Model for the Jubilee Year 2025

As the Church begins the Jubilee Year 2025, all Christians are invited to experience a time of renewal, reconciliation and grace. This special year encourages us to reflect on God's mercy, turn away from sin, and share in His healing work. Among all the examples of faith, one stands out as a perfect model for living in extraordinary ways through everyday life: the Blessed Mother. Her life of humility, faith, and service shows us how to live during the Jubilee.

The Divine Mother's life teaches us how ordinary moments can be filled with extraordinary grace. Her journey started not with something grand, but with simply saying "yes" to God's plan. When the angel Gabriel appeared to her and asked her to become the mother of His Son, she agreed without seeking fame or honour. Instead, she chose a life of obedience, trust, and service. Her quiet faith in God's plan marked every moment of her life.

The Blessed Virgin Mary's example shows that holiness isn't about doing big, dramatic things. It's about living faithfully in the everyday moments. As we prepare for the Jubilee, we are reminded that holiness is found in small acts of love and humility. Like the Our Lady, we can open our hearts to God's will, trusting that He will turn our ordinary moments into opportunities for grace.

The Jubilee Year also invites us to experience personal conversionturning

away from sin and renewing our commitment to God. The Most Holy Virgin's life shows us the way of continual conversion. From the moment she agreed to God's plan at the Annunciation to her words at the wedding in Cana, "Do whatever he tells you," the Divine Mother teaches us to always be open to God's guidance. Her life shows that conversion is a lifelong journey, made up of daily choices to follow God's will, even when it's difficult.

The Church invites us to reflect on God's mercy during this Jubilee and experience reconciliation with God and with one another. Our Lady, the Mother of Mercy, is a perfect model of reconciliation. At the foot of the cross, she saw her Son suffer and became part of God's work of reconciliation. In her suffering, united with Jesus', she offered herself as an intercessor for all people. Through her love, the Divine Mother leads us to experience God's mercy.

At Pentecost, the Blessed Mother's presence with the apostles shows her role in God's plan of reconciliation. She prayed for them as the Holy Spirit came down. She teaches us that reconciliation is not just about words, but about being willing to suffer for others, forgive, and work for peace. The Jubilee calls us to be instruments of peace in our families, communities, and the world, just as the Divine Mother was.

Peace is another important theme of the Jubilee Year 2025. The Blessed Mother, the

Queen of Peace, shows us that true peace isn't just the absence of conflictit's the presence of God's love. Her life teaches us that real peace comes from trusting God's plan. At the Annunciation, she accepted the unknown with faith, believing God would bring peace. Even in tough times, her peace came from trusting God. During the Jubilee, we are called to embrace peace in our hearts, knowing that God is in control, even when life feels uncertain.

The Blessed Mother also teaches us the importance of silence and prayer. In a world full of noise, her life of quiet reflection is a powerful example. After Jesus was born, she "pondered all these things in her heart" (Luke 2:19). Her life of prayer helped her stay faithful, even in difficult moments. The Jubilee reminds us of the power of silence and stillness, allowing God to shape our hearts. Silence can be a tool for reconciliation, conversion, and peace.

Finally, the Queen of Heaven's life was marked by humble service. She never sought recognition but always served others. Whether helping her cousin Elizabeth or supporting the early Church, the Immaculate Mother showed that true greatness is found in serving others. During this Jubilee, we are called to follow her example of service. Every act of kindness, no matter how small, shows God's love in the world. We can imitate her example by helping others, caring for the poor, and advocating for justice.

Inaugural Event of Ordinary Jubilee 2025 – A Celebration of Faith, Unity, and Hope

The Diocese of Baruipur marked a monumental moment in its spiritual journey as it officially inaugurated the Ordinary Jubilee 2025, on the 29th of December, 2024, in line with the Holy See's decree. This extraordinary event began with a vibrant and sacred ceremony that united hearts, minds, and souls in prayer, reverence, and joyful celebration.



On the afternoon of the inauguration, the Palli Unnayan Samiti Baruipur's premises became the sacred ground for the grand beginning of this momentous occasion. The event was marked by the presence of around 600 faithful, many religious women and men, about 40 priests, and Rt. Rev. Shyamal Bose, the Bishop of Baruipur, along with Bishop Emeritus Savadore Lobo. Under the graceful leadership of Fr. Tushar Augustine Gomes, who served as the master of ceremonies, the atmosphere was charged with fervent faith.

The opening ceremony commenced with a grand procession of the Priests, Bishops and the altar servers who proceeded towards the altar with the Jubilee Cross, a powerful symbol of Christ's love and sacrifice. This cross was placed at the heart of the altar, setting the tone for the spiritual journey ahead.

Bishop Shyamal Bose, with a voice full of blessing and love, led the congregation in a prayer of unity. To mark the inauguration of the Jubilee year, the release of a dove displayed a beautiful representation of peace, soaring high as a sign of hope for the world. Mr. Ashim Campoo read a portion of the *Spes Non-Confundit*, the Bull of Indiction, in Bengali, connecting the faithful to the heart of the Jubilee's theme. The Gospel was then read by Fr. The congregation witnessed a beautiful rite of the commemoration of Baptism, following which the Holy Eucharist continued with the singing of the gloria.

Before the Holy Mass concluded, Fr. Ujjwal Mondal shared an inspiring overview of the upcoming Jubilee 2025 program, offering a glimpse into the spiritual journey that lies ahead. To help all believers stay connected to the vision of the Jubilee, a special booklet detailing the Synodal process and key aspects of Jubilee 2025, Fr. Pradeep Roy, after a short introduction, called upon the Bishop

to release the booklet, the first copy of which was presented to Mr. Rupchand Baidya, a Core Committee member of the Jubilee.

The celebration concluded with words of appreciation from Fr. Kanauj Roy VG, acknowledging the dedicated participation and cooperation of everyone involved in making this event a resounding success.

This grand inaugural event of 2025 years of the birth of Christ was not just a ceremony; it was the start of an extraordinary journey that will deepen the faith of the Diocese of Baruipur. As we step together into this year of grace, renewal, and spiritual growth, may this Jubilee be a beacon of peace, love, reconciliation and hope for all.
