Lessons from the Message of Lourdes

I went every day for a fortnight, and each day I asked her who she was, and this petition always made her smile. After the fortnight I asked her three times consecutively. She always smiled. At last I tried for the fourth time. She stopped smiling. With her arms down, she raised her eyes to Heaven and then, folding her hands over her breast she said, "I am the Immaculate Conception." On December 08, 1854, Pope Pius IX proclaimed the dogma of Immaculate Conception in the Apostolic Constitution *Ineffable Deus.* A little more than three years later, on February 11, 1858, a young lady appeared to Bernadette Sourbirous. There began a series of visions. During the apparition on March 24, the lady identified herself with the words: "I am the Immaculate Conception".

"I saw a lady dressed in white, she wore a white dress, an equally white veil, a blue belt and a yellow rose on each foot." recounted Bernadette later. Bernadette made the Sign of the Cross with the lady and they prayed the Rosary together in silence. When the prayer ended, the most beautiful lady suddenly vanished. Four years later, in 1862, the Bishop of the Diocese declared the faithful "justified in believing the reality of the apparition." Pope Leo XIII authorized a special office and a Mass, in commemoration of the apparition, and in 1907 Pope Pius X extended the observance of this feast to the entire Church. Bernadette was later canonized as a saint in the Catholic Church for living a holy life. She lived the Message of Lourdes she received for all of us in the Grotto.

important lessons we can draw from the

making the sign of the Cross with our Lady she was no longer frightened. The Trinitarian invocation dispels fear and gives way to peace and courage to travel the journey of spiritual warfare on this earth.

- 2. Do everything for Heaven, our true home: Our Lady said to Bernadette, I do not promise you happiness here. It is in carrying our crosses united to His Cross that we can find joy. Bernadette said, "I can do everything for Heaven, my true home". This teaches us to give up parochial worldly values and goals and be armored to live for eternal life.
- 3. To hear the message of Revelation from the heart: During the third apparition, on February 18, 1858, the Virgin spoke for the first time: "What I have to say to you does not have to be written down". This means that Mary wished to communicate with Bernadette in a loving heart to heart way. From the very start, Bernadette was invited to open the depths of her heart to this message of Love.
- 4. Respect for fellow human beings:
 Bernadette was overwhelmed by the second statement of the Virgin Mary: "Would you be so kind as to come here for fifteen days?" It is the first time that Bernadette was addressed in a formal way. She felt she was respected and loved, as a person in her own right. We are all worthy of respect in the eyes of God, because He loves each one of us. This respect needs to be translated to all the other human beings who are created in the image and likeness of God.
- 5. God still loves the sinners: In Bernadette's time the Grotto was a dirty, hidden, damp and cold place. The Grotto was called the "pigs' shelter" because that was where the pigs feeding in the area usually took shelter. This tells us that God comes to join us where we

- are, in the midst of our poverty and failures. The place of apparition reminds us of the stable where the incarnation took place. God loves us as we are and makes persistent effort to make us respond to him.
- 6. Miracles do happen: The miracles of the Gospels are true and continue today at Lourdes. Over 7000 scientifically documented medically inexplicable cures remain on file in Lourdes of which the Catholic Church has proclaimed 70 as miracles. "With God all things are possible."
- 7. Why me?: Bernadette suffered from Asthma and stomach problems after the cholera and tuberculosis outbreaks. She was sickly even at the moment she was called. St. Bernadette said, "If good God allows it, there must be something good in it for me".
- 8. A life of penance: The message of Lourdes is the Good News of the Gospel message of prayer, penance and poverty. Like each of us, Bernadette had suffering in her life. Penance can be a suffering or sacrifice, a prayer or a good work offered for someone away from God. Our life, with all the joys and sorrows, can be offered as a penance to gain spiritual merit for ourselves and others. It does a lot of good in the Kingdom of God by fostering repentance.
- 9. Our Mother is with us: Prayer is a conversation between us and God. She prays with us, listens to us, lifts our prayers to God through her motherly heart. She prays with us as she did with Bernadette every time she met in the Grotto. We are never alone.

As we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes on February 11, let us ask for the grace of responding to the revelation of God in our life. May our Lady bless each one of us in our journey towards heaven.

PALLI UNNAYAN SAMITI BARUIPUR

The social service wing of the diocese directed its machinery towards the well being of the under privileged people of the society with special focus on children, adolescents, women and differently able persons. They helped 86 persons of Sandeshkhali to obtain disability certificate and avail *Manobikbhata* from Government schemes.

In its effort to alleviate the victimized families Linkage meeting for counseling and rehabilitation was organized on January 03, 2024 at Fulmalancha Gram Panchayet under Basanti Block. 35 representatives from ASHA, ICDS, NGO, CVC, AGG, village leaders and Local police participated and enhanced themselves to be at the service to the victims and access benefit and other emergency help.

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Rallies and Street Plays on social violence such as underage marriage, human trafficking, domestic violence against women and children were conducted at Dabu village under Canning Block I and Nabagram Gram Panchayet under Baruipur Block on January 10 and 23, 2024 wherein there were 137 participants. In pursuit of the same there was also a training for strengthening Community Vigilance Community on January 18 & 19, 2024 for 37 selected persons who would be rendering their support to dispel violence and abuse against women and children. In line with the same concern a mass awareness campaign at "Sundarban Birsa Munda Adibasi Tusu Mela" was held at Bariya village of Chunakhali Gram Panchayet under the Basanti Block on January 23, 2024. The posters, banners and leaflets were displayed and distributed among 750 people as means of Mass Campaign.

Capacity Building Training on Children's Parliament was facilitated by Mr. Pralay Bayen for 36 selected adolescent boys and girls from January 11-12, 2024. The participants Boys and Girls were stimulated to act towards mitigating the social evils of the society and be the instruments of change in the life of their peer group.

The school choir filled the stage and captivated the attention of the audience with their melody and charm. On the 100 years of the book *Abol tabol* by Sukumar Ray, the students of class 3 to 6 remembered the poet by reciting poems from *nonsense verse*. All the energetic performances charmed the audience and they in turn applauded. The main attraction of the function was the drama of the Trial Scene from The Merchant of Venice by William Shakespeare, enacted by the students of class 7 and the dance drama based on the theme Let's Fly that depicted the mental struggle of the children torn in between the competition and the urge to be free and fly high.

The school which was started in 1980 as a Bengali Medium Primary school had been converted into a full fledged English medium School in 2015. It has now about 420 children on its rolls from preprimary to class VII. A new building is being put up with the help of donors and well-wishers to accommodate the growing number of children and give better facilities and amenities.
