#### **Exaltation of the Cross**

"We should glory in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, for he is our salvation, our life and our resurrection: through him we are saved and made free." (The entrance antiphon for the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross)

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, also called Universal Exaltation of the Holy and Life-Giving Cross or Holy Cross Day, recalls three historical events, namely, (1) The finding of the True Cross by St. Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine in 320 AD, (2) The dedication of two churches built by Constantine on the site of the Holy Sepulchre and Mount Calvary in 335 AD and (3) The restoration of the True Cross to Jerusalem in 629 AD by the Byzantine emperor Heraclius II from the Persians.

The universal symbol of the Christian faith, the Cross, represents Christ's victory over death. The feast celebrates the redemptive transformation of a barbaric instrument of torture into a divine "tree of life" that brings hope to humankind. The cross is a sign of suffering, a sign of human cruelty at its worst. But by Christ's love shown in the Paschal Mystery, it has become the sign of triumph and victory, the sign of God, who is love itself. The feast, more than anything else, is a celebration and commemoration of God's greatest work: his salvific death on the Cross and His Resurrection, through which death was defeated and the doors to Heaven opened.

The founder of Opus Dei, St. Josemaria Escriva, always had great devotion to the crucifix. He recommended the people to kiss it at the beginning and end of their work; on going to bed and getting up; while making an act of faith, hope and love, asking God that we may make up in our own lives, as Saint Paul said, "What is lacking in the suffering of Christ." Every night, he would devoutly kiss the crucifix he used during the day, placing it afterwards in the pocket of his pajama-jacket. He wanted to feel it close to his heart when he woke up in the night. Saint Josemaria always wore a reliquary round his neck in the form of a cross containing a lignum crucis, a fragment of the True Cross. It was a manifestation of his devotion to the Holy Cross in the loving fulfillment of everyday duties. There are hundreds of ways, also small ones, to express this devotion in daily life, such as making the sign of the cross when saying grace before and after meals: "That moment of blessing, however brief, reminds us of our dependence on God for life; it strengthens our feeling of gratitude for the gifts of creation; it acknowledges those who by their labours provide us with these goods; and it reaffirms our solidarity with those in greatest need." (Pope Francis, Encyclical 'Laudato Si', no. 227). The symbol of Christian faith has ever been and always will be the Cross, for it is the sign of our redemption by our Lord Jesus Christ. When we make the sign of the Cross hurriedly and carelessly, St John Chrysostom says: "the demons rejoice in this frantic waving." On the other hand, the Cross traced correctly, with faith and reverence, dispels demons, calms sinful passions, attracts Divine Grace and gives us the strength to do good.

Believers have always looked to the cross in times of suffering. People in concentration camps, in prisons, in hospitals, in any place of suffering and loneliness, have been known to draw, trace, or form crosses and focus their eyes and hearts on them. The cross does not explain pain and misery. It does not give us any easy answers. But it does help us to see our lives united with that of Christ. In trials and temptations, the cross is a sign of strength and protection. The cross is the sign of the fullness of life that is

The feast of the exaltation of the Cross has a great significance as follows.

- A reminder of the Primary Symbol of our Faith: It is the primary symbol of our faith. In the cross we celebrate the change in our belief system. We look at it as the 'Tree of Life' which replaces the 'Tree of Death' in the Old Testament.
- 2. A reminder of our Vocation to Carry our Daily Cross: The Lord has very clearly said that if we wish to be His disciples then we need to forget ourselves, take up our daily crosses and follow Him (Cf. Lk 9: 23). Each one carries a unique cross. Let us identify them and turn to the Lord who has given us a sign of victory in the form of the Cross.
- 3. There is no Neutrality regarding the Cross: Pope Francis said that we cannot remain neutral regarding the Cross of Jesus. Either we are with Him or we are against Him. A choice is made before every action, for the actions of a Christian are none other than the testimony of how "God has loved us so much that he gave His only Son, Jesus".
- 4. A Sure Sign of Hope: The Cross is a sure sign of hope. Our heart, mind and soul are strengthened when it is exalted through our lives. Brokenness gives way to wholeness; sinfulness gives way to a life of virtue; pride paves way for humility; and hopelessness and despair gives way to renewed and rejuvenated way of thinking.

I wish you all a happy feast of the exaltation of the holy Cross. May the Cross lead us to a life full of love and hope to make each one of us a witness of the Paschal Mystery.

নারী ও শিশুদের নির্যাতন এবং সহিংস্রতা থেকে সুরক্ষা (Women & Child Protection against Abuse & Violence) ও অপ্রাপ্ত বয়সে বিবাহ থেকে মেয়েদের সুরক্ষা (Protection of Girls from Underage Marriage)। এই প্রকল্প-দুটি সুষ্টভাবে সম্পন্ন করতে এই সংস্থার অভিজ্ঞ কর্মীবৃন্দগণ, নারীদের কাছে অনিরাপদ অঞ্চল (Vulnerable Area Mapping) এবং নির্যাতিত নারী ও অসুরক্ষিত নারীদের আগে ভাগেই চিহ্নিত করেছিলেন (Vulnerable Beneficiary Mapping)। এছাড়া কোন উপায় অবলম্বন করলে তাঁদের সুরাহা হবে, সেই বিষয়ে এই সকল মহিলাদের (মেয়েদের) সাথে আলোচনা (Participatory Learning Action - PLA) করা হয়। সুতরাং চলতি বছরে প্রথম ধাপে অত্যন্ত অভাবী ২৯১ জন মহিলাদের জন্য ৭টি প্রত্যন্ত গ্রামে তিন মাস ব্যাপী রূপচর্চা বিষয়ক প্রশিক্ষণ শিবিরের (Beautician Course) আয়োজন করা হয়।

এই সকল দুর্বলশ্রেণীর মহিলাগণ শুধুমাত্র রূপচর্চায় নিপূণতা লাভ করেন নি, তাঁরা এই প্রশিক্ষণ থেকে তাদের মেক-আপ, পোশাকের শৈলী, পোশাকের মিশ্রণ-ও-ম্যাচিং, কেশের আকষণীয় বিন্যাস এবং কীভাবে শরীর এবং মুখের গঠনের সাথে মেলে এই সমস্তকে একত্রিত করে সুচারু ভাবে নিজেদের উপস্থাপন করতে হয় সে সম্পর্কে প্রশিক্ষণ গ্রহণ করেছিলেন। পাশাপাশি তাদের আন্তঃ-ব্যক্তিক যোগাযোগ উন্নত করাও ছিল এই প্রশিক্ষণের একটি অঙ্গ।স্বর্গেরি এই শিক্ষাব্যবস্থায় তাঁদের সকলকে smart করে তুলেছে।


