### I Thirst - The Cry of my Dying Savior - St. Therese of Child Jesus

Therese of Lisieux, the Patron saint of missionaries, is one of only three women to have been made a Doctor of the Church. Her mother died when Therese was 4. One by one, her four older sisters left for the cloister. She became emotionally clingy. She mentioned that she was far from meriting the graces showered upon her by the Lord. Though she had the ardent desire to advance in virtue, her numerous imperfections became a block in her spiritual journey. She could not correct herself of her extreme sensitiveness. She knew that she needed a miracle, without which she couldn't dare to hope to be admitted into Carmel. This miracle took place on Christmas Day, 1886, just nine days before Therese's fourteenth birthday.

"On that blessed night the sweet Infant Jesus, scarce an hour old, filled the darkness of my soul with floods of light. By becoming weak and little, for love of me, He made me strong and brave; He put His own weapons into my hands, so that I went from victory to victory, beginning, if I may say so, "to run as a giant" (Cf. Psalm 18[19]:5). The fountain of my tears was dried up, and from that time they flowed neither easily nor often(The Story of a Soul)". That Christmas night, Therese received the grace of a complete conversion. Though she had labored for years to overcome her extreme sensitivity and her tendency to cry over everything. She could not change her nature. But God could, and He did. "On this night of grace, the third period of my life

began the most beautiful of all, the one most filled with heavenly favors. In an instant, Our Lord, satisfied with my good will, accomplished the work I had not been able to do during all these years (The Story of a Soul)."

After Therese's complete conversion, she entered her fourteenth year of life with a newfound love of sinners. "From that day the cry of my dying Savior – "I thirst!" – sounded incessantly in my heart, and kindled therein a burning zeal hitherto unknown to me. My one desire was to give my Beloved to drink; I felt myself consumed with thirst for souls, and I longed at any cost to snatch sinners from the everlasting flames of hell(The Story of a Soul)."

Shortly after discovering this new thirst for sinners. Therese became aware of a notorious criminal named Pranzini who was soon to be executed for his crimes and who had shown no sign of repentance. Therefore, this new little apostle for sinners used "all the spiritual means" she could think of to bring about the conversion of Pranzini's soul. Though she was fully confident God would answer her prayer, she asked for a sign of his repentance, since this was her "first sinner". "My God, I am quite sure that Thou wilt pardon this unhappy Pranzini. I should still think so if he did not confess his sins or give any sign of sorrow, because I have such confidence in Thy unbounded Mercy; but this is my first sinner, and therefore I beg for just one sign of repentance to reassure me(The Story of a

Soul)."Sure enough, Therese received her sign. Just before his execution, despite the fact that he refused to confess his sins and receive absolution, the newspaper recorded that Pranzini, moved by what seemed to be a sudden inspiration just before death, embraced a crucifix held out by the priest and kissed it three times. Therese's prayers were answered, and she had won her first sinner for Heaven.

It took Therese the remaining years of her life to understand all the meanings and challenges of her complete conversion, and to accept and appreciate all its fruits. But this 'day of graces among all days' revealed all the blessings that Therese needed to comprehend and live her Little Way of Spirituality. She knew with certainty that it was God's path for her.

Br. Joseph Schmidt, FSC, writes about seven fruits which Therese experienced from her conversion and which were foundational to her growth in the science of love and in the development of her Little Way. Some of these fruits were immediately obtained while others developed slowly over time. The seven fruits are (1) The grace of personal enlightenment or selfawareness, (2) Understanding that her conversion was a free gift of God and that she needed only 'good will' to receive it, (3) Freeing her from the path of violence to herself, (4) "Enabling her to respond to her father on her father's terms, (5) A new understanding of the path of authentic love, (6) A new understanding of the path of 02 October 2023

authentic zeal, and (7) A new inner strength and courage.

One of the important sayings of Jesus towards humanity is "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand (Mt 3: 2)." In this conversion becomes a call. On the other hand, it is a grace which is infused through divine intervention into a soul which desires and cooperates with the plan of God

revealed through the paschal mystery in His Son Jesus Christ. When Therese found difficult to come out of her own weaknesses and longed for a miracle, it truly happened. The foundation of Sainthood was laid in the work of conversion through His grace. As years went by, the fruits contained in the experience of conversion was fully realized. The soul which is touched by God cannot

but spread the light of God into other souls. Hence Therese took the life-long initiative of converting hardened sinners by immersing them into the passion and death of the Lord. As we celebrate the Feast of Therese on the 1st of October, let us renew our trust in the Lord for the grace of conversion.

### Visit of Most Rev. Gebhard Furst from Germany



On September 1, 2023 Most Rev. Gebhard Furst paid a visit to the diocese of Baruipur. He along with Most Rev. Shyamal Bose and four other distinguished guests from the diocese of Rottenburg - Stuttgart, Germany went to Gosaba, one of the islands of Sundarban. The intention of the visit was to capture the present living scenario of the people of Sundarban. While visiting they interacted with the people and came to know that the adverse effect of global warming is an alarming threat to Sundarban and it's inhabitants. They witnessed the struggle of the people to cope with frequent flood and cyclone practically every year. As a result, sustainable agriculture, migration and displacement of people have become burning survivle issue in

Sundarban. The visiting team had a meaningful exposure to capture the living conditions of the people in Sundarban. On behalf of the people of Sundarban we express our thanks and gratitude to Most Rev. Gebhard Furst and his team for their concern for the people of Sundarban.

### **NGO Coordination Meeting**

There was consecutive NGO Coordination Meeting on September 15, 20 and 21, 2023 in Kakdwip, Basanti & Mathurapur Blocks under the banner of Global Programme India. The aim of the meeting was to exchange the idea and share the working experience on DRR resilience model in Sundarban region.

Altogether 76 representatives from 27 NGOs actively participated in the coordination Meetings. The NGO representatives prepared a Quaterly action plan, including maintenance of the multi purpose cyclone centre (MPCS). They also developed a DRR plan and submitted to Sundarban Development Authority.





#### **Nutritional Food Material and Toiletries Distribution**

On September 18, 2023, Nutritional Food Materials and Toiletries were distributed among the 329 Students of SAD Langalberia to prevent malnutrition. The food kits contained Soybeans, Pulses (Lentils), Bengal Gram, Sugar, Sooji, Horlicks, Biscuit, Vivel soap, Sunlight Detergent Powder, Tooth Paste, Coconut oil and Shampoo as Toiletries.

### **Vegetable Seeds and Sapling Distribution**

On September 29 & 30, 2023, twelve varieties of vegetable seeds and saplings of Mango, Coconut and Lemon were distributed among 800 families belonging to marginal Farmers in Namkhana and Patharpratima Block in the District of South 24 Parganas. The Aim of the program was to promote Nutrition Garden and Horticulture towards accessing the vegetable and fruits by their own and also Surplus can be sold out to add some earning for their better survival.





# Inauguration of Beautician and Computer Training with Spoken English Course

On September 29, 2023, Computer Training Center for underprevillaged Youth in Gosaba and Beautician Training course for Marginalized Girls and Young Women in Basanti was inaugurated.

The objective of the program intervention is to develop their vocational Skill and link them in the job market or Self-employment for earning opportunity as alternative income. The program is supported by Manos Unidas.
